ROYAL BRITISH LEGION

THE ROYAL BRITISH LEGION IS THE UK'S LEADING ARMED FORCES CHARITY. THEY PROVIDE PRACTICAL, EMOTIONAL AND FINANCIAL SUPPORT TO ALL MEMBERS OF THE BRITISH ARMED FORCES PAST AND PRESENT, AND THEIR FAMILIES.

THE BRITISH LEGION WAS FOUNDED IN 1921 AS A VOICE FOR THE EX-SERVICE COMMUNITY AS A MERGER OF FOUR ORGANISATIONS: THE COMRADES OF THE GREAT WAR, THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF DISCHARGED SAILORS AND SOLDIERS, THE NATIONAL FEDERATION OF DISCHARGED AND DEMOBILIZED SAILORS AND SOLDIERS AND THE OFFICERS' ASSOCIATION.

IT WAS GRANTED A ROYAL CHARTER ON 29 MAY 1971 TO MARK ITS FIFTIETH ANNIVERSARY, WHICH GIVES THE LEGION THE PRIVILEGE OF THE PREFIX 'ROYAL'.

THEY ARE PERHAPS BEST KNOWN FOR THE ANNUAL POPPY APPEAL AND REMEMBRANCE SERVICES, THE ROYAL BRITISH LEGION RUNS ONE OF THE LARGEST MEMBERSHIP ORGANISATIONS IN THE COUNTRY AND IS RECOGNISED AS THE CUSTODIAN OF REMEMBRANCE FOR THE NATION.



BRITISH RED CROSS

THE BRITISH RED CROSS HELPS PEOPLE IN CRISIS, WHOEVER AND WHEREVER THEY ARE.

IT WAS FORMED IN 1870, JUST SEVEN YEARS AFTER THE FORMATION OF THE INTERNATIONAL MOVEMENT IN SWITZERLAND. THIS FOLLOWED THE OUTBREAK OF WAR BETWEEN FRANCE AND PRUSSIA, AND A MOVE ACROSS EUROPE TO FORM SIMILAR SOCIETIES.

ON 4 AUGUST 1870, THE 'BRITISH NATIONAL SOCIETY FOR AID TO THE SICK AND WOUNDED IN WAR' WAS FORMED. IT ASSISTED IN PROVIDING AID TO BOTH WARRING ARMIES IN THE FRANCO-PRUSSIAN WAR AND SUBSEQUENT 19TH CENTURY CONFLICTS, UNDER THE PROTECTION OF THE RED CROSS EMBLEM.

IN 1905, 35 YEARS AFTER ITS FORMATION, THE SOCIETY WAS RECONSTITUTED AS THE BRITISH RED CROSS SOCIETY, AND WAS GRANTED ITS FIRST ROYAL CHARTER IN 1908 BY HM KING EDWARD VII AND QUEEN ALEXANDRA, WHO BECAME ITS PRESIDENT.

TODAY, THEY ARE PART OF A GLOBAL VOLUNTARY NETWORK, RESPONDING TO CONFLICTS, NATURAL DISASTERS AND INDIVIDUAL EMERGENCIES. THEY HELP VULNERABLE PEOPLE IN THE UK AND ABROAD PREPARE FOR, WITHSTAND AND RECOVER FROM EMERGENCIES IN THEIR OWN COMMUNITIES.
